That half mile of pipe should be done by December 8, 2016. Board member Brett Harrison has worked ten hour days, five days a week, helping to get this job done. A huge "thank you" to Brett and the crew for the terrific job. Marnie Kurbat and Donna Hancock had let the district use their water hose to water and soak the bridle path. Thank you, homeowners. Homeowners Lee Dunning welded our stand pipe wheels. Victor Armendariz gave some corrugated pipe for our new stand pipes; Board member Eldon Graber loaded the truck to haul away old concrete, from the 39th Avenue lot. Renee Breeden, Lynette Gray, and Dorrie Sullivan worked all day on our election for the Board of Directors, as voting judges. We appreciate your competence in your assistance. Congratulations are in order for Brett Harrison for achieving his second term, on the Water Board's Board of Directors. He has been an asset for all of us homeowners.
